3. Privacy Policy

By accessing www.cramaaveresti.ro implies the users' implicit acceptance that their personal data to be stored and processed by SC VINICOLA Averesti 2000 SA. The purposes of processing are for creating a database for statistical reports , information about SC VINICOLA Averesti 2000 SA promotions or any other promotions or activities of SC VINICOLA Averesti 2000 SA by any means of communication (mail, e- mail , telephone , SMS, etc.). SC VINICOLA Averesti 2000 SA undertakes not to disclose your personal data to third parties except direct marketing operator (thereof). Your personal data will be transmitted to the authorities in order to check commercial transactions or other authorities the right to carry out any checks, whether this will be requested in accordance with the law.

SC VINICOLA Averesti 2000 to certify that respect the rights conferred by Law no. 677/2001 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data, and the Law no . 365/2002 on electronic commerce. 2. The right to request SC VINICOLA Averesti 2000 SA to correct, update, block or delete, free of charge, provided the data whose processing does not comply with Law no. 677/2001;
3. The right to request SC VINICOLA Averesti 2000 SA to cease, free of charge, the processing of your personal data;
4. The right to request SC VINICOLA Averesti 2000 SA to stop sending promotional messages.
5. Your right to notify SC VINICOLA Averesti 2000 SA that you waive the purchase without penalty and without giving any reason within 10 days of receipt of product or in case of services, from the contract signing through return the product bought in this period in original packaging with all accessories and without showing any trace of damage or wear, supporting customer shipping costs under the existing regulations. This right may not be invoked in the case of products taken from our siege or our directly delivered by our staff to the customer.

Averesti Winery uses security measures against the loss, misuse or alteration of information that is under its control.

Limitations on the use of certain means of distance communication

Art. 1. - The following distance communication techniques require the prior consent of the consumer:

4. The Use of Cookies Policy

This policy relates to cookies and Web pages operated by SC VINICOLA Averesti 2000 SA Wine Averesti hereinafter, registered with the Trade Register under no . J37 / 49 / 2000 and having the Unique Registration Code: RO12784424.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small files consisting of letters and numbers that will be stored on your computer or other mobile terminal equipment of a user who accesses the Internet. Cookies are installed following the request issued by the web server to a browser (eg Internet Explorer, Chrome) and is completely "passive" (does not contain software viruses or spyware and can not access the information on the hard driver User).

What are cookies used?

These files make it possible to recognize the user's terminal and presenting relevant content in a manner adapted to user preferences. Cookies provide users a pleasant experience browsing and support efforts of SC VINICOLA Averesti 2000 SA to provide user comfort : ex - privacy preferences regarding online shopping cart or relevant advertising . They are also used in the preparation of anonymous, aggregated statistics that help us understand how a user receives our web pages, allowing us to improve the structure and its contents, excluding the personal identification of the user.

What cookies we use?

We use two types of cookies: per session and fixed. The latter are temporary files that remain in the user's terminal until the end of the session or closing the application (web browser). Fixed cookies remain fixed on the user's terminal over a cookie parameters or until manually deleted by the user.

How are cookies used by this site?

Visiting this site may place cookies for purposes of:

- Cookies for Site Performance
- Cookies for analysis of the visitors
- Cookies for geotargetting
- Registration Cookies
- Cookies for advertising
- Cookies of advertising providers
- Cookies for remarketing services of Google AdWords

Do cookies contain personal data?

Cookies themselves do not require personal information to be used and, in most cases, does not personally identify internet users. Personal data collected by using cookies can be collected only to facilitate certain functionality to the user. Such data are encrypted in a way that makes it impossible for unauthorized person to access them.

Deleting Cookies

In general, an application used to access web pages allows you to save the cookies by default terminal. These settings can be changed so that the automated cookie to be blocked by the web browser or the user is informed whenever cookies are sent to the terminal. Detailed information about the possibilities and ways of managing cookies can be found in the setup application (web browser). The limit use of cookies may affect some functionalities of the web page.

Why cookies are important for the Internet?

Cookies are the focus of the efficient operation of the Internet, helping to generate a friendly browsing experience and adapted to each user's preferences and interests. Refusing or disabling cookies may make some sites impossible to use.

Refusing or disabling cookies does not mean you will not receive online advertising - but it will not be able to recognize your preferences and interests, evidenced by browsing behavior.

Examples of important uses of cookies (that do not require user authentication through an account):

- Content and services tailored to user preferences - categories of products and services.
- Offers tailored to the interests of users - withholding passwords.
- Withholding child protection filters on Internet content (family mode options, functions Safe Search) .

- Limiting the frequency of broadcast commercials - limiting the number of hits and advertisement for a particular user on a website.
- Providing advertising more relevant to users.
- Measurement , optimization and analytics features - such as confirming a certain level of traffic to a website, what type of content is viewed and how a user arrives on a website (eg through search engines directly from other websites etc) . Develops these analyzes websites to improve their use websites for the benefit of users.

Security and confidentiality issues

Cookies are not viruses! They use text formats. There are not composed of pieces of code and can not be executed so neither can self- run. Consequently, you can not duplicate or replicate on other networks to run again. Because, they can not perform these functions can not be considered viruses.

Cookies can still be used for negative purposes. Since they store information about users' preferences and browsing history, both on a site and on several other sites , cookies can be used as a form of Spyware . Many anti -spyware products are aware of this and constantly mark the cookies to be deleted in proceedings removal / anti -virus scan / anti -spyware.

In general, browsers have integrated privacy settings that provide different levels of acceptance of cookies, the validity period and are erased automatically after the user has visited a particular site.

Other security issues related to cookies:

Because identity protection is very valuable and represents the right of every Internet user, it should know that any problems can create cookies. Because through them they constantly transmit information in both directions between browser and website, if an attacker or unauthorized person comes in during data transmission, the information contained in the cookie can be intercepted.

Although rare, this can happen if the browser connects to a network server using unencrypted network (ie unsecured WiFi network).

Other cookie -based attacks involve wrong setting of cookies on servers. If a website does not require the browser to use only encrypted channels, attackers can use this vulnerability to trick browsers into sending information through unsecured channels. Attackers then use the information for purposes of unauthorized access to certain sites. It is very important to be careful in choosing the most suitable method of protecting personal information.

Tips for safe surfing and responsible, based on cookies.

Due to their flexibility and the fact that most of the visited and largest sites use cookies , they are almost inevitable . Disabling cookies will not allow user access to the sites most widely used including YouTube, Gmail , Yahoo and others.

Here are some tips to ensure worry-free browsing while using cookies:

- Customize your browser settings regarding cookies to reflect a comfortable level of security for you using cookies.

- If you do not mind the cookies and you are the only person who are utilizing the computer, you can set expiration for long-term storage of browsing history and personal data access .
- If you share access to your computer, you can consider your browser setting to delete individual browsing data every time you close your browser. This is an option to access sites that place cookies and delete any information from visitors browsing session closes.
- Install and update your anti-spyware constantly.

Many applications of detection and prevention of spyware include detecting attacks on sites. This prevents the browser from accessing websites that may exploiting browser vulnerabilities to download software or dangerous.

Make sure that you keep your browser updated.

Many attacks are based on cookies are made by exploiting the weaknesses of the old versions of browsers.

Cookies are everywhere and can not be avoided if you want to enjoy access to the best and largest sites on the Internet - local or international. With a clear understanding of how they operate and the benefits they bring you can take the necessary security measures so that you can surf the Internet with confidence.

Disabling and refusal to accept cookies can make certain websites visited impassable or difficult to use. Also refusing to accept cookies does not mean you will not receive / view online advertising.

It is possible to set the browser so that cookies will not be accepted or you can set your browser to accept cookies from a particular site. But for example, if you are not registered using cookies, you will not be able to leave a comment.

All modern browsers offer the possibility to change the setting of cookies. These settings typically are found in the "Options" or "Preferences " menu of your browser.
